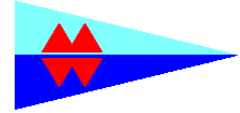


## MACWESTER OWNERS ASSOCIATION



### Joining Information

We are a Class Association, founded in 1966, catering for the owners of boats built to **C.J.Roy** designs including all Macwesters, the Atlanta Rockall, Atlanta Viking 800, Atlanta 28 and Atlanta 8.5. Although no longer in production the boats' reputation marches on. Currently our membership exceeds 250 and is steadily growing with both UK and International interest.

Our Association facilitates a lively exchange of ideas and experiences, as well as joys and fears, through **The Journal** which is published each Spring and Autumn and which is based upon contributions from our members.

We are able to provide much of the historic information and a wealth of practical and informative material that might otherwise be lost to the owner of a Macwester/Atlanta.

We hold three 'Flag Officer' rallies each year, and several 'Macmeets' at different locations around the UK coast. Some members who cannot attend by boat arrive by land. The evenings are usually centred upon local hostelries offering meals for those interested, with the result that many convivial evenings are enjoyed by all.

On joining the Association you will receive a pack comprising an Association Badge, an Association Burgee, (see Logo above) and an information pack containing articles about the Macwester and Atlanta Roy designs and their production.

Awards are presented to members in each year at the AGM which is usually held in London in January:

Arrowsmith Trophy	A silver rose-bowl for the best narrative log or article.
Cole Baggywrinkle Trophy	A lovely painting of a Macwester 26 for the best practical article.
Log Spinner Trophy	A mounted Log Spinner awarded for the best account of a long cruise which includes essential but not exhaustive details of weather navigation and execution useful to others planning a similar route.
Wit of the Year Award	£5 for the funniest poem, cartoon or article published in The Journal in any one year.
Macwester (Nore) Trophy	A fine cup awarded by the committee for a noteworthy achievement or service to the Association.
Photographic Award	For the best photograph exhibited at the AGM.

The Association is what members make it - contributions to The Journal, hosting a rally or Macmeet, or just taking part now and again. Owning a Macwester or Atlanta is more fun when you're in the MOA. We have a unique common bond.
